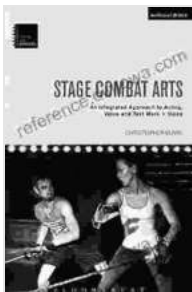

But his mind's made up. GORDON pockets the cash. DIANE puts the ring in the pocket of her button-down. He exits, hastily.

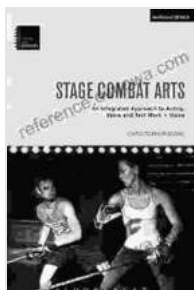

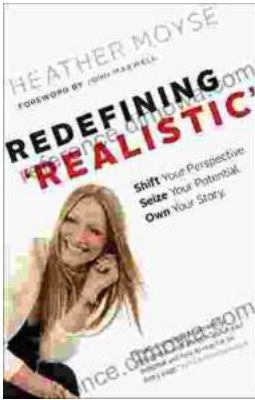

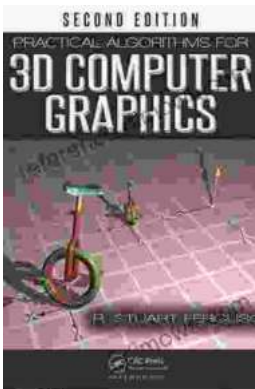
